

Sunset at Sunset Meeting

July 31, 2008

Present: Marci, Ann, Carol, Donna, Bev

1. Donna reported one call from a volunteer. Forms have been printed.
2. Marci reported the following:
 - a. Photo contest - will be on the Planetarium website. They are still undecided about the fee for a show the day of the event and may offer reduced prices.
 - b. Art Show – Waterway Art will do the show.
 - c. Car Show – There is a big show in Charlotte around the same time, but they think they will have enough cars for a show.
 - d. Kid’s Activities – Marie Munn will paint faces and will need two sets of paints. She has four painters who will do two shifts. She also has balloon clowns at a charge of \$20/hr. It was decided to have two clowns 2-5pm. It was also suggested that some inexpensive games or activities could be received from a dollar store as a donation.
 - e. Boat Show – Mike Williams will work on this.
 - f. Community Services – The Red Cross will have local representatives. They stated that there is not enough time to organize a blood drive. First Tee is enthusiastic about the event.
 - g. T-shirts – After discussion, it was decided to purchase both tee and golf shirts from Hatteras Embroidery.
3. Treasurer’s Report – Marci reported that the check for \$13,500 was received from the town and deposited in the committee account. The current balance is \$13,402.30.
4. Karen’s Report was given in her absence by Marci. The Marine Band has confirmed and will need lunch for 45 members. Shamalama has been booked for a fee of \$500. Brunswick Little Theater will perform Broadway show tunes. The Songbirds will perform for thirty minutes. The Brunswick Big Band will perform at the end of the event. Still looking for an additional band.
5. Ann reported progress on donors. Door prizes have been promised or donated from Island Breeze, Little Friends, The Fitness Studio, Pelican Books, Fibber McGee’s and Blue Heron. Still working on sponsors. Two donors also want exhibit/vending space.
6. Carol noted that exhibition only space is \$50.00, space for vendors is \$75.00. She has contacted several food vendors; St. Luke’s and Sunset Slush are confirmed so far.
7. Carol reviewed the site map with the committee and discussed locations for vendors, entertainment and parking.
