1. Treasurer's Report: balance in bank \$11, 068.21
2. Bridge Dedication:
 - a. Menu: will be finally determined closer to the event.
 - b. Tickets: Karen J. distributed two ticket prototypes for the committee's review. By phone, Jean H. told us that we could have as many as 350 persons in the space for the reception. Karen J. will get the tickets printed. Susan presented information about the use of a credit card for ticket sales. This could also be used for 5K race registration.
 - c. Book: Clarification from both Pelican Books and Jack deGroot that the book (Sunset Beach: A History) will launch at the Dedication Reception. Books will be available for sale and signing at the event.
 - d. Bus: Susan has obtained information. Bus holds 38 passengers. No wheelchair lift but can accommodate folding wheelchairs and walkers. She will get prices for unlimited trips for the designated hours.
3. 5K Run/Fitness Walk was approved by the Town Council. Next step is having town attorney approve language for disclaimer and developing entry form.
3. Bridge Remembrance Book: Karen J. showed an example of a remembrance book. Stories are beginning to come in. Karen will interview Mr. Gore to get material for a magazine article and also his stories for the remembrance book.
4. Ads: Committee reviewed and revised the dedication reception ad. Tickets will be sold by phone (Marci & Karen D.) and at Town Hall. Information will be available on the website.
5. Painting contest: Paintings will be due by September 15 and can be dropped off Sept. 1 through Sept. 15. They will be stored at Town Hall. Depending on the number of entries, the paintings will all be displayed at the reception.
6. Meeting with David Stuart: Marci and Karen D. met with David Stuart. He will arrange to have the large field (formerly used for parking) leveled, as well as eliminating the prickly pears and fire ants. He suggested having parking in the area designated for the Comfort Inn.
7. Fossil Dirt wants to return this year and Karen D. has spoken with them.
8. Adopt-a-Can: green garbage cans that chipped were not painted with the appropriate paint.
9. Vendor updates: Prior to the meeting, 20 vendors had committed. Others were submitted today.
10. Golf carts: Mike Williams has arranged for use of carts from Golf Cart Outlet.
11. Karen J. has talked with Karen Bolden from DOT. The dedication will take place on the street in front of Twin Lakes. The platform holds 25 people. In addition to the proposed bus, we could possibly use the limo from Bourbon St. and the shuttle from Sea Trail. Possibilities for rain were discussed.
12. Music times: 10:30 High school, 12:00 Marine Band, 2:30 Brunswick Big Band followed by shag music/dancing 4:00-5:30. Zumba for 30 minutes--11:30-12.
