1. Financial Update: We have approximately \$16,000.
2. Update on T-shirt: Two vendors have offered a price of \$7.50 for an order of 288 shirts. **Decision:** Order 288 shirts @ \$7.50. An next meeting review samples and choose vendor and colors.
3. Update on 5K Race: Ann reported that AthletePath (online registration) said they could not agree to accept overall liability for the race. Bonnie Schwerd was not able to attend the meeting. Ann has not received any further information from Bonnie. After discussing options and conferring with sponsors, it was felt that it would not be feasible to have the race without online registration. **Decision:** Cancel this year's race. Ann will email persons who have already inquired about this year's race and those on the email list from previous years. Ann will also notify the timing company and race sponsors.
4. Advertising Comparisons: The committee reviewed and discussed the costs for ads in the Brunswick Beacon, Myrtle Beach Sun, and North Myrtle Beach times. **Decision:** purchase two ads (color). 1) Brunswick Beacon, Island Living supplement on Labor Day weekend 10 x 10 at a cost of \$800.00. 2) North Myrtle Beach Times 11.5 x 10.5 at a cost of \$804.00.
5. Entertainment: The contract for Jason Cox was deemed acceptable by Bonnie Schwerd. Bev will forward it to him. Marge should hear from the Marines by July 31. If they come there will be thirty (30) members and they will bring their own sound system. Karen Joseph has reserved the Sandpiper Bay Residents Center for their lunch. Lois has spoken to the VFW who will be pleased to prepare lunch for the Marines again.
6. Vendor Update: Jean Hutchinson has sent an email to all vendors, reminding them to submit their application and fee. Bev has emailed several jewelery vendors.
7. Sponsor update: Several sponsors have committed although forms and checks are not yet in.
8. ROTC Update: Jean is checking on the contact person. She is also waiting for a call back from the Boy Scout troop leader.
9. Photo Contest: Toby is unable to work on the committee for personal reasons but is willing to get three judges. Bev will coordinate with her. Karen J. is working on an outside person to assume responsibility for the photo contest.
10. A vendor has expressed concern over the fee since the individual is a small, one-person business. Committee concurred that the fee must be the same for everyone.
