CLASS TITLE: BEACH PATROL

**PURPOSE OF CLASS:** Responsible of enforcing Town Ordinances relevant to beach strand visitors.

Primary Tasks: Patrol, on an ATV, the beach strand to enforce Town Ordinances and issue citations to any persons violating town ordinances; litter control of any free flying litter or debris; public relations. Notify, by calling 911 immediately, the police department and/or fire department in emergency situations occurring on the strand including but not limited to: missing person reports, injuries/illnesses, disturbances or conflicts.

Equipment Operated: ATV

Reporting Relationship: This position reports to the Beach Patrol Supervisor and/or the Public Works Director.

Working Conditions: Shift work from 7 am – 7 pm, seven (7) days per week beginning one week before Memorial Day (May) and ending one week after Labor Day (September); Works involves general physical hazards of working with equipment and extreme exposures to heat and heat related inclement weather conditions; work involves heavy lifting, crawling and climbing in operation of the equipment.

Education: Graduation from a standard high school or GED equivalent.

Experience: Experience in the operation of an ATV, in public relations; working knowledge of police procedures and general knowledge of the area.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Good knowledge of town ordinances; skilled in public relations; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; ability to withstand exposure to varied climatic conditions; ability to work well with other employees and the public.

Special Requirements: Possession of valid North Carolina driver's license.
