Town of Sunset Beach Main Street Shoulder Paving and Resurface Project

Road work to begin soon!

Sunset Beach, NC - Sunset Beach has partnered with the State of North Carolina Department of Transportation (NC DOT) to widen Main Street (SR1177) during the milling and resurfacing of the entire length of Main Street. The milling and resurfacing project begins at the bulkhead located at the west end of the island to Canal Drive.

This widening project will include approximately 1.5 miles of bike lanes to improve the separation between pedestrians, bicyclists and vehicular traffic. The bike lanes will be located on both the north and south side of Main Street. The width of the bike lanes from 12th Street to 40th Street extends five feet on each side. The width of the bike lanes from 12th Street to Canal Drive extends four feet on each side. The bike lanes will taper from five feet to four feet at 12th Street on each side to accommodate the restrictions related to the bike lanes location within the Tubb's Inlet Hazard Area.

The initial construction preparation is scheduled to begin **March 7, 2016** with the installation of erosion and sediment control fencing and drop inlet improvements.

RESIDENTS NEED TO REMOVE OR RELOCATE LANDSCAPE, MAILBOXES, DRIVEWAY ROCK OR OTHER ENCROACHMENTS A MINIMUM OF FIVE FEET FROM THE EXISTING ASPHALT EDGE PRIOR TO THE MILLING AND RESURFACING START DATE OF APRIL 4, 2016. NC DOT WILL REMOVE THOSE ITEMS THAT REMAIN WITHIN THAT FIVE FOOT AREA AND ANY OTHER ITEMS LOCATED WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY THAT IMPEDES THE INSTALLATION OF THE BIKE LANES OR DROP INLET IMPROVEMENTS. ITEMS REMOVED WILL NOT BE REPLACED OR REINSTALLED.

The asphalt milling, resurfacing and widening is scheduled for completion on **April 30, 2016** and the final project completion date including high visibility crosswalks, stripping and final grading is scheduled for completion on **May 20, 2016**.
