

Town of Sunset Beach Welcomes You!

Beach Rules

1. No person shall walk, ride an animal or operate a vehicle of any type on, over or upon any sand dune lying within the town limits.
2. Only Emergency and Official Vehicles are allowed on the beach.
3. Only non-glass containers are allowed on the beach.
4. Pets shall remain on a 10 ft. or less leash and under the control of a responsible person.
5. Beginning the Friday before Memorial Day thru Labor Day pets are permitted on the beach during the hours before 9:00 am and after 6:00 pm.
6. Pet owners are required to pick-up and dispose of their pet feces.
7. No littering on the beach strand.
8. No open fires on the beach.
9. No fireworks and sparklers are allowed on the beach.
10. Do not take, disturb, or destroy any sea turtle nest or eggs.
11. Remain on the beach access walkways when crossing the dunes.
12. Beach holes should not exceed 18 inches in depth or 5 feet in width and must be filled-in prior to leaving the beach.
13. No Tents, Cabanas or Canopies are allowed between 1st and 27th Street.
14. Commercial cabana vendor/rental enterprises are required to obtain a permit prior to erecting cabanas for their customers.
15. Tents/Cabanas should not exceed 12' x 12' and anchor tie-downs must be placed within tent footprint. There must be a 10 foot space between tents. Place rear of tent in alignment with the two adjacent beach trash can poles.
