Afternoon Dr. Hilderman,

The financial responsibility for the survey is that of the applicant. The permit fee is for field assessment, processing and coordination, etc. of the application. The survey would be used by the resource agencies to evaluate any impacts to shellfish resource during the application review process. Other agencies may request additional surveys dependent on their area of concern.

As for the PNA designation, this is what I've been able to uncover. With data and reports from almost 40 years ago from a time of a paper archival system, there unfortunately may be some lost information. I've been told a report was done around the mid 70's for the central portion of the state, but indicates there was no report completed for the southern region, though data was available. The juvenile trawl program conducted by NC DMF does evaluate nursery areas, and requires 3 years of data to assess a classification change. I am not sure of the exact process though there are criteria, with some regional differences.
