Financial Report: Money available: \$23,000.00 from which expenditures will be paid. Expenditures will include: entertainment/band, tents, tables and chairs, children's play area, advertising and cleanup.

Vendors: To date, we have 36 vendors which include crafts, businesses and foods. One more was received in the mail today. Karen will recheck the vendor list as it was noted that others were not on the printed list.

Sponsors: Bob reported that forms have been delivered to both previous and potentially new sponsors and we are waiting for their responses. To date, we have 6 sponsors.

Entertainment: Discussion concerning contract submitted by one performer. Committee felt that there were details that were not applicable to our festival. Bob informed the committee of another possibility for entertainment.  
Decision by the committee: Karen and Bob will reach out to the two performance groups and present what the committee requests. A decision will be made by the committee to see if the requests can be honored.

Rack Cards: These will be distributed throughout the community in June. It was suggested that distribution be broadened to included places in Little River and North Myrtle Beach. We have many vendors from these areas.

Advertising: Use the North Myrtle Beach Times, Beacon, and Star News. It was felt that the Sun News did not give enough attention to Sunset Beach area.

Rockin' Democracy: This event will take place June 16 and the committee will make every attempt to attend. Possibility of finding new vendors.

Sponsor Photos: Karen will be making the "checks" so that committee members can have pictures taken with the sponsors. These photos will be given to the BEACON and also to be used on our Facebook page.

Parking Volunteers: Carol Malm and Bob will head up the search for volunteers for parking. Need approximately 24 people to park cars for that day. Cindi will speak with individual who chairs the community service personnel. Our festival could be a possibility for community service requirement.
